Carsey/The Washington Center Education Award Program

UNH undergraduate students who have successfully completed an internship through The Washington Center (TWC) are eligible to receive a \$5,000 Education Award to pursue a master's degree at the Carsey School of Public Policy in: Community Development (MCD), Public Administration (MPA), or Public Policy (MPP).
