- Limited poll hours






- Only signature required (min.)

- No pre-registration (max.)





1. State culture – which in many cases also predicts COVI values. But not in NH.

- 2. The closeness of elections
 - The attention paid to elections
 - The amount of campaigning that takes place.
- 3. Education NH is 8th
- 4. Income NH is 9th



Which party benefits from easy voting?


1. Initially, it was the Democrats who were concerned.

2. After 2008, the Republicans began to worry. Easy Vote


3. Then, Trump spreads lies about election fraud.
