Choose the Master's Degree Program Right for You

- **Master in Community Development:** This online program can be completed in 14 months and is ideal for community focused recreation, tourism development, recreation planning, nonprofit leadership, and federal, state, or local parks and recreation careers.
- **Master of Global Conflict and Human Security:** This online program can be completed in 1 year and is designed for students interested in international development, sustainability, conservation, governance, natural resource conflict, and community resilience.
- **Master of Public Administration:** This online program can be completed in 12 to 16 months and prepares students for leadership roles in parks & recreation administration, nonprofit management, municipal or state government, emergency management, and public service.
- **Master in Public Policy:** This online program can be completed in 16 months and prepares students for careers in public lands policy, tourism development, sustainability, conservation, advocacy, and policymaking.
